## ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-4581, served August 29, 1997. No opposition to the request has been received. However, although the petition is titled one for stay pending judicial review, respondent does not indicate that he has filed such a petition, nor does he state that he intends to do so. It appears that good cause would exist for granting the stay, were a request for judicial review to be filed. Accordingly, we will assume respondent has or will timely do so.<sup>1</sup>
